Internet Explorer, Chrome (on Windows)

- 1. Internet Explorer, Chrome, and Safari use the operating system's certificate store for Internet browsing. If users will be using these browsers, you must install the certificate into the certificate store for the OS.
- 2. double-click the certificate file and select Open. Select Install Certificate to launch the Certificate Import Wizard.

3. Use the wizard to install the certificate into the **Trusted Root Certificate Authorities** store. If a security warning appears, select Yes to install the certificate.
